Whereas, the Westchester Toughman is the final, capstone event of the now Annual Croton Bike Week; and

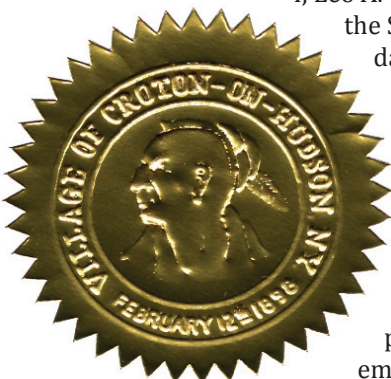
